BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

MANAGER'S REPORT

n Monday, November 13, 1995, your Park Paseo Board of Directors met at the clubhouse for its regularly scheduled meeting. President Ric Cox called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. Also present were directors Ernie Jones, Mike Krahelski, Jeff McCoy, and Ann Kahn, and association manager Perry Carter,

The minutes of the October 9 BOD meeting as well

as the Oct. 16 & 23, 1995 annual meetings and the Oct. 23 organizational meeting were approved. Nine homeowners who were three or more months in arrears in their dues were sent 30-day pay-or-lien letters, and one homeowner four months in arrears was sent a 10-day letter from our collection attorney. Minutes from the October Architectural committee meeting were approved as well as October's financial records.

A request from the GSA of Orange County to use the clubhouse as a polling place was de-

nied on the basis that the clubhouse is a private facility for use by homeowners and their guests, and that the school is available for this use.

The babysitting co-op was granted a fee-waived use of the clubhouse for a holiday party. Manager Perry Carter's request for four hours of computer training to handle financial year end reports was approved. The Board approved the bid of \$16,000 by Champion roofing to re-roof the clubhouse in December.

ithin the next two to four weeks, several major association projects will commence. The clubhouse roof will be replaced as its useful life has expired. It will be torn off and re-roofed with a concrete composition material that has a fifty year warranty. It will be done in a simulated rustic shake design. The project will take approximately five days to complete and will be scheduled so as to not dis-

turb any clubhouse activities.


Tree trimming and pruning of 168 trees and the necessary removal of 11 dead or diseased trees will be done in early December by Chaidez Tree Service. The trimming crews will be working throughout the complex for three to five days. Your patience during the noisy times and clean-up period will be appreciated.

Replacement of the 16 year old main pool filters will be completed in early December. Four new Purex stainless steel filters with rotor-type backwash valves will be installed on pads in the enclosed

pool equipment storage area. The existing system will be re-plumbed to adapt to the new filters. The pool will be shut down for three to four days during the installation and advance notice will be posted as to when this will occur.

Lastly, please accept my sincere wishes to each of you for a most happy holiday season and a very prosperous new year.


