## NORTHSTARS SWIM SEASON BEGINS

n Monday, March 11, 1996, your Park Paseo Board of Directors met at the clubhouse for its regularly scheduled meeting. President Ric Cox called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Also present were directors Ernie Jones, Mike Krahelski, Jeff McCoy, and Ann Kahn, four homeowners, and association manager Perry Carter. The minutes of the February 12, 1996 BOD meeting as well as the min-

utes from the February architectural committee meeting were approved as corrected. The financial records from February, 1996 were also approved.

Eight homeowners who were three or more months in arrears in their dues were sent 30-day pay-or-lien letters, and three homeowners four months in arrears were sent a 10-day letter from our collection attorney.

**Northstars** president Ron Finney requested a schedule of swim team practice times and swim meets for the upcoming season. He also requested that


the Board allow non-Park Paseo swimmers to be part of the Northstars this year. The Board requested a joint discussion between our Board and the swim team board at the April 15 regular meeting.

Two homeowners requested we trim a windrow eucalyptus tree that has grown over their property line and has branches rubbing against their home. The Board approved cutting it back.

Manager Carter stated that violation notices have been sent out and that we are going through due process.

The Board offered congratulations to Park Press editor Ric Cox for being selected again as "Newsletter of the Year" in the 501-1,000 unit category.

The Board adopted a **Schedule of Fines and Fees** for infractions by homeowners (A copy will be sent to all homeowners in the near future.)

Manager Carter announced that a CD in the amount of \$95,000 had been purchased through Smith Barney with a rate of 5% which matures 3/13/97.

The Board directed manager Carter to find the best rate at a federally insured institution for another \$95,000 in reserves that is scheduled to mature on 4/15/96.

The Board approved a bid of \$540.00 by Bacon Door Company to replace the decaying doors on the spa equipment room.

Manager Carter announced that the Alba greenbelt landscaping had been completed and that the upgrades to the main pool area would be next.

The Board agreed that the April meeting would be held on Monday, April 15, 1996 because of the Easter holidays.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:00 p.m.

I will take this opportunity to remind all homeowners that exterior painting of your residence and all other changes or improvements require approval of our Association's Architectural Committee prior to any work commencing.

All forms for painting and changes may be obtained at the clubhouse office and I will be happy to discuss the proper completion of the forms with you when you pick them up. The painting form is only one page and requires paint chips for trim, siding, and stucco. The same form is used for new garage doors and must be accompanied by a brochure photo of the new door.

All other exterior additions/improvements require the use of the **Home Application form** which has detailed instructions for completion as well as required plans and blueprints.

Failure to obtain the necessary prior approvals constitutes a violation of the CC&R's and may require modification or removal of unauthorized work at the expense of the homeowner.


The Association is fortunate to have an Architectural Committee comprised of qualified and reasonable members of long standing as well as a licensed architect.
