#### **BOARD HIGHLIGHTS**

# n Monday, April 15, 1996, your Park Paseo Board of Directors met at the clubhouse for its regularly scheduled meeting. President Ric Cox called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Also present were directors Ernie Jones, Mike Krahelski, Jeff McCoy, and Ann Kahn, eight homeowners, and association manager Perry Carter. The minutes of the March, 1996 BOD meeting as well as the minutes

from the March architectural committee meeting were approved as corrected. The financial records from March, 1996 were also approved.

Fourteen homeowners who were three or more months in arrears in their dues were sent 30-day pay-or-lien letters, and three homeowners four months in arrears were sent a 10-day letter from our collection attorney.

Northstars president Ron

Finney, along with other swim team board members were present to continue the discussion relative to their proposal to use

non-PPHOA swimmers on the swim team. Concerned homeowners presented opposing viewpoints in a spirited discussion. After hearing input from both sides, the Board denied the swim team's request. It offered to assist with fund raising and to assist in any way possible to increase the size of the team from within the Association. The Board approved swim team requests to use the clubhouse/pool for three ISL training sessions in April and May.


## NORTHSTARS SWIM TEAM UPDATE

On manager Carter's first anniversary at Park Paseo, the Board unanimously renewed his one year contract with thanks and commendations from all for learning the job so quickly and making the transition from previous management a smooth one.

Two CD's were purchased for reserve funds from Smith Barney. A one year CD in the amount of \$75,000 with a yield of 5.3% and a six-month CD in the amount of \$35,000 with a yield of 5.1% were approved by the Board.

The Board approved Santiago Hills' 6th grade graduation party on June 20 at our clubhouse. The Board also approved a swim party for 5th graders from a nearby school on June 11.

The Board voted to renew membership in NIVA at a cost of \$100. Manager Carter's request to attend two CAI seminars on April 16th and 19th was approved also.

The Association's 1995 audit prepared by Francis J. Keenan, C.P.A. was reviewed and approved, and management was requested to mail it to all homeowners according to California Civil Code.

The Board asked manager Carter to have our security company's representative attend the next meeting to discuss lapses in gate unlocking procedures.

The Board thanked Shelley Armstrong of Coldwell Banker for a successful Easter egg hunt.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:30 p.m.

he Christamon pool/wader and the Prosa pool are currently heated to 80 degrees and are on summer schedule which means that they are heated continuously, and may continue to be, depending on weather conditions, until the official summer schedule begins in June.

Presently, lifeguards are on duty only on Saturday and Sunday from noon until 6:00 p.m. This schedule will be maintained until the official summer schedule begins. During the summer season, lifeguards will be on duty seven days week from noon 'til 8:00 p.m. at the Christamon pool and noon 'til 6:00 p.m. at the Prosa facility.

The security guards will be on duty Fridays from 5:00 p.m. 'til midnight, Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to midnight, and Sundays from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The summer schedule for the security guards will be seven days a week from 10:00 a.m. to midnight.

In the interest of safety, please remember that lifeguards are only on duty Saturdays & Sundays until June. Swimmers must be 14 years of age or older to use the pool unless supervised by an adult
