COMMUNITY NEWS: Northstars Signups Set

n Monday February 8, 1998, your Park Paseo Board of Directors met at the clubhouse for its regularly scheduled meeting. President Jeff McCoy called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Also present were directors Mike Krahelski, Ann Kahn, Ernie Jones, and Ric Cox, manager Perry Carter, and an officer from the Park Paseo Northstars.

The minutes of the January 1999 BOD meeting were approved as corrected. The financial records from January 1999 were also approved. The minutes

The Board directed management to send thirty day letters to six homeowners three months in arrears and ten-day letters to five homeowners four months in arrears. One account was sent to the attorney for collection.

The Board approved two requests from Santiago Hills school to use the pool and clubhouse for end-of-the-year events. The fifth grade will hold their traditional last day of school pool party on June 23, 1999 from 10:00-2:00 p.m. and the 6th grade will hold their promotion dance later that evening.

The Board voted to authorize Frank Keenan, CPA to prepare the 1998 tax return and audit at a cost of \$2,200.00 which is the same cost as last year.

Management was requested to have one more tree planted in the greenbelt north of the Prosa pool to add privacy for adjacent homeowners.

MANAGER'S REPORT: Home Improvement Time

pring (and right behind, summer) are rapidly approaching and this is the time when most home improvement projects are done. I will take this opportunity to remind all homeowners that exterior painting and all other changes or improvements require approval of our association's Architecture Committee prior to any work commencing.

Applications for painting of your residence (or any other changes) are available at the clubhouse office. I

will be happy to discuss the proper completion of the forms with you when you pick them

up. The painting form is only one page long and requires paint chips for trim, siding, and stucco colors to be attached. This same form is used for new garage doors and must be accompanied by a brochure photo of the proposed door.

All other exterior additions or improvements require the use of the Home Improvement Application Form which has detailed instructions for completion as well as required plans and specifications. A reminder: Failure to obtain necessary prior approvals constitute a violation of our C C & R's and cou d require modification and/or removal unauthorized work at the expense of the homeowner plus a \$50.00 fine.

Architecture Committee meetings are held on the last Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. in the clubhouse. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to call me and discuss them.

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
