

Manager's Report: Spring Pool Schedule

he Christamon pool/wader and the Prosa pool will be heated to 80 degrees in time for Spring Break on April 16th and will be heated continuously through the end of the break on Sunday, April 22nd.


During this time a security guard will be on duty at the main pool from 10:00 A.M. until midnight daily to record your key number, check keys, and sign you in. Lifeguards will be on duty from 12:00 noon 'til 6:00 P.M. at both facilities. Pool hours are: Christamon pool 7:00 A.M.-10:00 P.M. Sun-Thurs and Fri-Sat 7:00 A.M.-11:00 P.M. Prosa pool hours are 7:00 A.M.-9:00 P.M. Sun-Thurs. and 7:00 A.M.-10:00 P.M. Fri-Sat. As a reminder, the following association "Green Tag" access rules will be strictly enforced.

GREEN TAGS are designed for youths 10-13 who are water safe and have obtained written permission from their parents and PPHOA through a "Green Tag application program." They may swim without parents **WHEN A LIFEGUARD IS PRESENT**. Requirements for obtaining and keeping a Green Tag are:

- Paying a \$1.00 fee
- Passing a beginning Red Cross test given by the association's pool monitor/lifeguard
- Not bringing guests into the pool area
- Keeping the Green Tag with you at all times
- Not lending your Green Tag to another (penalty for infraction is loss of tag for 10 days.)
- Following the directions of pool monitor/life-guard/security guard at all times. (Penalties for violation are: 1) warning 2) sit-out period determined by pool monitor, and 3) loss of tag for swim season.

Applications for Green Tags may be obtained at the clubhouse. Bring a copy of your birth certificate, \$1.00, and a positive attitude. I will be happy to review the application process and help you schedule your test with the pool monitor.
