The minutes of the February 2001 BOD meeting were approved. The financial records from the February, 2001 meeting were also approved. The minutes from the February Architectural Committee meeting were approved. The Action items/responses from the February BOD meeting were reviewed.

The Board directed management to send thirty-day letters to eleven homeowners three months in arrears in their dues, and ten-day letters to three homeowners four months in arrears.


During this time a security guard will be on duty at the main pool from 10:00 A.M. until midnight

Manager's Report:

Recent influx of complaints from homeowners have made the following reminders necessary:

- 1. Trash to be picked up weekly by Waste Management Company is not to be put out for pickup until the evening before the day it is to be picked up, and trash receptacles are to be removed from view not later than the same evening of the day the trash was picked up.
- 2. This is the time of year when recreational vehicles are most heavily used, and those using them are reminded that parking any recreational vehicle over seven feet long or any detached trailer are prohibited on public streets or within association property except for loading or unloading the vehicle.

Your cooperation in preventing any of the above items becoming a major issue will be greatly appreciated.


Upcoming Spring Means Home Projects
