The Association's audit for calendar year 2000 was reviewed and approved, and it was noted that revenue over costs and expenses was \$21,254.00.


A proposal by Reserve Data Associates to do a reserve study at a cost of \$940.00 was reviewed and approved.

City Hearings on Local Development


The city of Irvine will be holding hearings regarding the upcoming development from Diamante East to Jeffrey. So far there have been no decisions made as far as density or types of residences. Residents of Park Paseo, and especially those who border the affected development area will want to keep informed. The city and developer want to continue Hicks Canyon, and Orange Arrow through to Jeffrey in some configuration, and is proposing installing traffic lights there. This would negatively impact "our world." Residents along Hicks Canyon, Diamante, Orange Arrow and close locations will be affected. Park Paseo has requested additional information, and will keep the populace informed through the Park Press.

Manager's Report: Summer Swim Season

he summer schedule at both the Christamon Pool and the Prosa Pool will commence on June 18th and continue through the summer, and perhaps longer depending on weather conditions. During this time, lifeguards will be on duty from 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. at the Christamon Pool, and from 12:00 noon to 6:00 p.m. at the Prosa Pool each day.

Security guards will be on duty from 10:00 a.m. to midnight daily at the Christamon Pool. They will be stationed just under the patio enclosure to sign homeowners in. Please be cooperative in signing in and showing your key, so we can maintain our beautiful facility, and eliminate trespassers.

REMINDERS

- 1. Children under 14 years of age <u>cannot</u> come to the pool unless accompanied by an adult (18 years of age or older) The only exception to this is a child who has a valid, registered Green Tag who may come to the pool <u>any time a lifeguard is on duty</u>. They may not bring guests.
- 2. Blue Tag swimmers (on the Northstars) may only come to the pool unsupervised when their age group is practicing during official swim team practice.
- 3. Babysitters bringing children to the pool must be physically present at all times with the children, and must supervise them at all times. Babysitters cannot be outside the pool area when their charges are inside.


