#### Summer Lifeguard Schedule

The summer schedule at the Christamon Pool will commence on June 21 and continue through the Labor Day weekend. During this period lifeguards will be on duty only at the Christamon pool from 12:00 noon until 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and on weekends from 12:00 noon until 8:00 p.m. There will be no lifeguard service at the Prosa pool. Security guards will be on duty at the Christamon pool from 5:00 p.m. until closing seven

days a week. Guards will periodically leave to inspect the Prosa facility. Please make sure gates are closed.

#### **Pool Reminders**

Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older). The only exception to this rule are children who have a valid, registered green tag who may come to the pool any time a lifeguard is on duty. They may not bring guests. Swimmers must be 18 years of age to use the spa without supervision. Babysitters bringing children to the pool must be physically present at all times with the children and must supervise them at all times. Babysitters

cannot be outside the pool area when their children are still inside. Your cooperation is much appreciated.


also illegal. Since many households own multiple vehicles, please be respectful of your neighbors.

When selecting decorative lights, choose Energy Star light emitting diodes (LED's) that are exceptionally energy-efficient and use up to 90% less energy than incandescent bulbs to produce the same amount of light. Switch to CFL's! Replace lights & lamps with compact fluorescent (CFL) bulbs which last up to 10 times longer.

## BOARD HIGHLIGHTS

On Monday May 10, 2010 your Park Paseo Board of Directors met at the clubhouse for its regularly scheduled meeting. Present were Directors Howard Scott, Mike Krahelski, Tanja Fournier, Roland Philipp, and Brian Hagadorn. Also present were co-managers Gus Aarnaes and Ric Cox and one homeowner. The minutes of the April 12, 2010 BOD meeting were approved as corrected. The Action Item Responses Report from the April 12, 2010 meeting was also reviewed.

The Board reviewed architectural violations regarding failure to put away trash receptacles and a home in need of repainting. The Board observed evidence that the homeowner has begun to put away trash receptacles on a regular basis and deferred any fines. The second homeowner requested additional time to complete the house painting. The BOD approved a resolution to give

the homeowner until June 30 to repaint his home.

The BOD directed management to get bids to replace our Park Paseo monument signs at the entrances to our community.

The BOD approved a re-

quest from the SHS fifth grade classes for a pool party on June 23 subject to receipt of a deposit. The BOD reviewed and approved a proposal from Surgener Enterprise to repair & reseal the concrete decks at the Prosa & Christamon pools at a cost of \$4,335.00.

The BOD directed management to get bids to construct new Park Paseo monument signs at the entrances to our community. The old signs have outlived their usefulness and the BOD is unwilling to wait any longer for SCE to tie into their transformer. Park Paseo Northstars president. Mary Condy reported on the progress of the upcoming swim season and told the BOD that enrollment stood at 101 swimmers. She requested BOD assistance in recruiting swimmers to fill out the 120 swimmer ISL maximum. The BOD acknowledged the Stone Family at 18 Diamante (see photo page 4) for winning the monthly landscaping award.

The violation log was reviewed. The financial material for the First Quarter 2010 was reviewed and approved. The delinquent account report was discussed and management was requested to send out four 30-day reminder letters and one attorney warning letter. The BOD also directed management to communicate to our attorney that a homeowner-requested payment plan that did not have the effect of reducing the dues balance was not acceptable.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:36 p.m., and the next Board meeting is scheduled for June 14, 2010 at 6:30 p.m.

**Summer Safety Tips** 

When exercising in hot weather be sure to drink plenty of fluids and wear one layer of light-colored elothing. Never leave a child or pet in a hot car, even for a moment. Make sure metal slides are cool to prevent children's legs from getting burned. Be sure to report damaged equipment immediately.

Children should never ride skateboards or scooters in or near traffic. All skateboarders and scooter riders should wear a helmet and other protective gear; wrist guards, knee pads, and elbow guards.

#### **IRWD** Freebies

The IRWD (Irvine Ranch Water District) provides many free services to its customers. Among them are **Water-Use Surveys**— where a trained water conservation specialist visits your home and shows the customer how to check for leaks. evaluates landscaping 'irrigation systems, and provides a report with water saving suggestions for reducing water use to allocated levels.

The IRWD also provides Low-Flow showerheads (along with a supply of Teflon tape) free of charge to cut your water usage. Faucet aerators for kitchen/bathroom sinks are also provided to assist in reducing water usage. If you suspect that your toilet is leaking you may pick up red dye tablets to look for 'silent' leaks. The preceding items may be picked up at no cost at IRWD headquarters, 15600 Sand Canyon Ave. in Irvine 7:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m. M-Thurs & 8:00-5:00 Friday.

#### Playground Sand In Pools


Monday morning is our regularly scheduled pool maintenance day and this week I was greeted by the pool maintenance person, expressing disbelief at how much sand had accumulated in the children's wading pool over the weekend. It was as though there was more sand in the wader than in the playground! Please understand how harmful this is to the pool pump and circulation equipment and filters. The sand acts as sandpaper on the internal parts of the pumps and the filters plug up prematurely and eventually tear apart and have to be replaced. This becomes a significant maintenance expense to the association.

Please help us all minimize repair and maintenance expenses by not allowing the little ones to run back and forth between the sandbox and pools. Let's all try to keep that sand out of the pools!

#### **Recreational Vehicles**

With summer and vacation time rapidly approaching, please be reminded that recreational vehicles, boats and trailers cannot be parked on streets or driveways within the association except to be loaded or unloaded. Longer than one day is a violation of the CC &R's.
