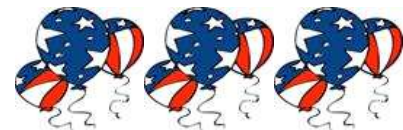

Just as sure as fireworks will fly on the 4th of July, news will be reported on July 5th that won't be as pleasant. Someone, somewhere will be injured, or worse, in a fireworks accident. It happens every year. Although fireworks are enjoyable and exciting to watch, each year they injure thousands of people, many of them children, and cause thousands of fires. Federal and state laws prohibit the sale of certain types of fireworks, but even those that are legal can be dangerous. For example, sparklers, burn at temperatures of approximately 2000 degrees. Because fireworks can be dangerous and deadly, the safest way to enjoy them is at a public display put on by professionals.
