#### Community Update

Over 80 Park Paseo residents turned out in force on October 12th to hear about the upcoming community projects and express concerns over communication with the membership. You spoke, and we heard! Following are some of the results of that meeting:

- ✓ Douglas B. Koresh, Harvest Landscape's certified arborist was in attendance to present his findings about the three large ficus trees in front of the clubhouse on Christamon West. The Board resolved to keep the trees, but will strategically remove the overhang limbs and root prune to limit further asphalt and concrete damage.
- Tanja Fournier, Board Treasurer and Landscape & Aesthetics Committee Chair. presented a PowerPoint summary of the turf removal, Planning Area 5B, and landscape renovation projects that the Board has been working on for over a year. With California's declared state of emergency due to the drought, the Board and Committee have been seeking alternatives to the water-intensive turf (see http://ca.gov/drought for details). Through the diligence of Tanja and the Committee, the association was able to qualify for \$288K in turf rebates with the Irvine Ranch Water District, the last HOA to receive such a rebate before the funds were no longer available. - The Board confirmed to move forward with the turf replacement project, starting on Orange Arrow from Yale to the Christamon West intersection, including the clubhouse frontage. Turf removal will not affect the ficus trees in front. For a copy of the Committee's presentation, please go to the association's website at www.parkpaseoirvine.com.

✓ The Board will finalize a budget at the November 9th meeting for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016. The budget packet will be distributed to all homeowners on or before December 1, 2015 in accordance with California Civil Code.
