June/July Board Meeting Recap

The Park Paseo Board of Directors meeting was held on Monday, June 27, 2016 due to the 4th of July holiday. Items covered by the Board included:

- The Landscape & Aesthetics Committee presented the clubhouse refresh plan, scheduled for September. The new plan includes flooring, paint, furniture and some fun additions. Please note that the clubhouse is slated to be closed for most of September to get this work done.
- The Board voted to use only organic herbicides, if any are used at all. Additionally, only organic pesticides are used at the clubhouse that are non-harmful, but do have an odor for approximately an hour after use.
- A new door was approved for installation on the tennis court side of the clubhouse due to the deteriorated condition of the original door.


We are pleased to announce that Park Paseo has a brand new website for the exclusive use of our members. We invite you to visit as soon as you can. Follow these easy steps:

Project Priority #1

Four (4) light bollard types have been selected as potential replacements for the walkway lights throughout the community. The Board will review proposals from three (3) qualified contractors at the August 1st meeting to do this work.

Turf Renovation Project Update

Project Priority #2

A rebate check in the amount of \$288,000.00 has been received from the Municipal Water District of Orange County as reimbursement for the turf that was replaced throughout the community. These funds will cover all expenses for new plants in the areas where turf was removed, and also provided enough funds to renovate a number of existing planters. The Board is still working with Southern California Edison (SCE) to have a new pedestal installed at Yale and Orange Arrow that will allow for automated watering in that area.

Monument Sign Project Update

Project Priority #3

The Board of Directors resolved to have three (3) monuments installed with the monument sign project: one at the clubhouse, one on the clubhouse side of Yale and Orange Arrow and one on the Prosa Pool side of the same corner.

Parking Courtesy

The Board has received multiple complaints regarding the parking situation in our community. Please remember that when you park too many vehicles on the street, it makes parking difficult for not only our residents, but quests to our community as well. Our streets are the property of the City of Irvine, and all Irvine parking laws apply. Vehicles in violation of the City's parking laws will be cited/towed as necessary including those vehicles that extend into the roadways and cut off clearance on the cul de sacs. Residents are reminded to please use your garage and driveway for parking your vehicles before utilizing street parking. Also note that vehicle repairs cannot be performed when the vehicle is on the street and our CC&Rs prohibit the parking or storing of commercial vehicles, oversized vehicles, boats, trailers, campers, motor homes, buses, etc. within the Association. Thank you for adhering to the Park Paseo Parking Rules. We count on all residents to do their part.

Weed Abatement

Park Paseo HOA has partnered with Harvest Landscape to explore weed abatement options that use natural methods to rid the newly renovated areas of weeds in our community without impacting the environment. The product the landscapers are using is called "Avenger" and is manufactured by Avenger Organics, a company based in Georgia. Avenger is an all-organic product that uses citrus oil and has no posting requirements prior to application.
