## August Board Meeting Recap

The Park Paseo Board of Directors meeting was held on Monday, August 8th, 2016 due to a scheduling conflict on August 1st. Items covered by the Board included:

- The Board of Directors will consider a potential pool key change-out in the off-season for the recreational facilities throughout the community.
- With the upcoming clubhouse remodel, existing furniture will be available to the membership for personal use.
- The Alba Tot Lot will be refurbished shortly.
- The three (3) historical Ficus trees at the clubhouse will be trimmed in November in accordance with the new tree trim plan.
  - The three (3) dead trees along the paseo at the end of Ensueno will be removed, but the area they will be removed from is too small to support more windrow Eucalyptuses. Therefore, three (3) new 15-gallon silver dollar Eucalyptuses will be installed at the end of Campanero instead.
    - A preliminary, draft reserve study was reviewed by the Board of Directors and will be reconsidered at the September Board meeting.
    - Patio use permissions were clarified: No more than four (4) tables per family are to be used on the patio deck. Please be courteous of your neighbors when using the common area facilities - no more than 15 quests are permitted at one time without notifying the HOA in advance. Also, please do not place items out in the morning to "reserve" a spot for an afternoon event.
    - Board meetings have moved back to the 2nd Monday of each month, effective September 12th. Architectural Meetings will remain on the last Wednesday of each month with adjustments made during the holiday season.

## Clubhouse Furniture Can Be Yours!



## Turf Renovation Project Update

Project Priority #2

Harvest Landscape is working with the Board and the Landscape & Aesthetics Committee to finish the turf replacement project including upgrades to Area 9 (end of Alba) and Area 8 (Orange Arrow Park). \$288,000.00 was received from the water district for these projects and other potential landscape upgrades. It is important to note that Harvest is NOT using Roundup or other hazardous materials. If you see them with spray, please be assured that this spray is a new product called "Avenger" which is organic and uses citrus oil to eliminate weeds. Northstars 7-8 100 Yard Freestyle Relay of Lauren Giglia, Deron Hsia, Trevor Cheng, and Everett Chen placed 10th with a time of 1:15.45. Northstars 9-10 200 Yard Freestyle Relay of Sophia Fei, Jalen Hsia, Tyler Lin, and Samuel Groysman placed 10th with a time of 2:17.02. Northstars 11-12 200 Yard Freestyle Relay of Delaney Palmer, Ethan Chen, William Fei, and Josh Sellwood placed 8th with a time of 2:03.22. Northstars 13-14 200 Yard Freestyle Relay of Hannah Miller, Dylan Green, Sasha Constandse, and Paige Condy placed 10th with a time of 1:52.94. The overall season was a great success with 756 individual time improvements and 15 Park Paseo Northstars records set over the course of the ten week season. Park Paseo competed this season with teams from North Irvine, Northwood Pointe, Oak Creek, Village Park and Westpark.
