

The Board of Directors resolved to have three (3) monuments installed with the monument sign project: one at the clubhouse, one on the clubhouse side of Yale and Orange Arrow and one on the Prosa Pool side of the same corner.


#### Paint Color Rule Clarification

In the past, articles have been included in the newsletter related to architectural requirements for painting within the community. Some owners have requested that they be permitted to repaint with their existing colors, however, in an effort to update the community's look, owners have been asked to select from one of the paint palettes on file at the clubhouse or online. The Board of Directors is considering a rule clarification at their meeting on December 12th that would (a) permit the same colors be used as the existing colors as long as the HOA has the architectural approval on file and that the colors are earth tones (a paint color application is still required to be filed prior to painting); (b) permit any combination of earth tones to be submitted for consideration by the ARC; and (c) prohibit the use of variations of white on white palettes. If you have any suggestions or comments regarding this rule clarification, please submit them to marybeth.green@associa.us or drop them off at the clubhouse no later than December 7th or attend the meeting in December to express your opinion.
