November Board Meeting Recap

The Park Paseo Board of Directors meeting was held on Monday, November 7, 2016. Items covered by the Board included:

- The annual meeting results were reviewed.

 Congratulations to Mina Brooks and Yumi Renshus on their election to the Board of Directors!
- The Board accepted the resignation of long-time Board member Tanja Fournier with regrets and wished her well in her endeavors. If you are interested in filling this vacancy, please complete the attached form and return it to the HOA no later than Friday, December 2nd for the Board to consider an appointment at the December 12th meeting.
- The current reserve study was adopted.
- A budget was passed reflecting a modest increase of \$2.00 per unit, per month to \$106.00. With this budget, the HOA is now funding for future pool deck replacements as well as tree trimming on a plan. Look for your budget packet in a separate mailer.

Upcoming Project Update
