- Finalization of clubhouse rental agreement changes (see article on page 3)


Potential Use Of Roundup

With the record rains this past winter, communities all over Southern California are benefitting with new, lush plant growth. Unfortunately, that applies to a proliferation of weeds as well. Last year the Board of Directors instructed Harvest Landscape to stop using Roundup in conjunction with the City of Irvine's pledge to avoid using the product where they can. Roundup is not a banned substance and after concerns were expressed with CalEPA, the Orange County Agricultural Commissioner's Office reviewed the community to ensure that all safeguards were met, and they were. At the May 8th meeting, the Board will consider potential minimal Roundup usage in the community with proper notification via signage. Clubhouse Rule Changes

The Board of Directors has finalized the following rule changes for clubhouse rental as voted on at the April 10th Board of Directors meeting:

- ✓ Friday & Saturday rentals will be increased from \$200 per event to \$225 per event
- ✓ Holiday rentals will be increased from \$200 or \$175
 per event to \$225 per event, regardless of what day
- ✓ Failure to return remotes for the TV system will result in a \$50 deduction from the deposit on file
- Dance floor rentals will be removed from the form as no dance floor is needed with the new flooring.

City Of Irvine Rental Restrictions

Did you know that the City of Irvine prohibits short-term rentals for residential homes? The City defines short-term rentals as less than 31 days (City of Irvine Zoning Code 3-3-1). As Park Paseo is in Irvine, please do not permit rental of your property for less than 31 days at a time.

Roof paint must be Nutech Roof Coatings in one of the following approved colors:

- ✓ Wheat
 - ' Sandstone
- ✓ Sahara
- ✓ Grecian Terra Cotta
- Terra Cotta
- ✓ Earl Grey
- ✓ Shale Grey

Project Priority #1

Project Priority #2

The Board is still considering planting plans for the small pocket park at the end of Orange Arrow where the street bends at Prosa. A planting scheme will be reviewed at their next meeting. Please remember to keep your pets out of the newly installed planters -- pet waste can damage all of those beautiful new plants!

Monument Sign Project Update

Project Priority #3

Prior plans for monuments will be reviewed by the Board for selection of a type of monument to be considered so bids and detailed specifications can be obtained. Options to consider include lighting, lettering materials, size and surrounding plants. This will become a top priority for 2017.

Trash Cans

Trash cans are to be stored out of view of neighboring units at all times except on trash day (Monday). Inspections are taking place on Tuesdays by the onsite GM and courtesy reminder notices will be issued for trash cans still in view of the common area. Trash cans may not be stored on the side of units, in driveway, or in bushes. Each resident must have a designated, enclosed trash area that is screened from view of neighbors and the street (Arch guidelines 8a).

Mailboxes & Posts

Some mailbox posts are leaning, broken, dry-rotted, and in need of being painted. Courtesy reminder notices will be issued for those mailboxes/posts that are in need of repair/paint. Owners are responsible for keeping these areas in good condition at all times. If residents share the mailbox posts, it is up to the sharing owners to replace and maintain them. Architectural applications for replacement can be found on our website and clubhouse office during business hours.

Automatic Assessment Payments

There are several ways that you can pay your assessments (dues) for Park Paseo. Following is a summary of your choices and the costs associated with them. Contact Associa-PCM with any questions.

OPTION 1: Pay By Mail (cost of 1 stamp)

- Send your check each month when you receive your statement
- Return envelope and payment stub included

OPTION 2: Associa-PCM EFT (no cost)

- Sign up to have the monthly dues deducted directly from your bank account
- Current assessments are deducted, even if dues change
- You provide voided check and completed form via mail or email to Associa-PCM
- Forms available at the clubhouse, www.parkpaseoirvine.com or via email to lisa.gross@associa.us

OPTION 3: Pay Through Owner's Bank (pay bank's fees)

- Using your bank's online bill-pay system, you set up recurring payments
- Bank sends eCheck or hard copy check to the HOA's lockbox account
- You must notify bank to change amounts if dues change

OPTION 4: Pay Through PayLease One Time (\$2.95+3.5% + your card's fees)

- 3rd party company to pay bills online
- You designate amount to pay
- Fees incurred per transaction
- Can be used to meet deadlines

OPTION 5: Pay Through PayLease Recurring (\$2.95+3.5% + your card fees)

- 3rd party company to pay bills online
- ✓ You designate amount to pay monthly
- Fees incurred per transaction
- You must notify PayLease to change amounts if dues change
