May 2017 Board Meeting Recap

The Park Paseo Board of Directors meeting was held on Monday, May 8, 2017. Items covered by the Board included:

- ✓ Tennis ball donation approval (see article on page 1)

Potential Use Of Roundup

With the record rains this past winter, communities all over Southern California are benefitting with new, lush plant growth. Unfortunately, that applies to a proliferation of weeds as well. Last year the Board of Directors instructed Harvest Landscape to stop using Roundup in conjunction with the City of Irvine's pledge to avoid using the product where they can. Roundup is not a banned substance and after concerns were expressed with CalEPA. the Orange County Agricultural Commissioner's Office reviewed the community to ensure that all safeguards were met, and they were. At the May 8th meeting, the Board considered potential minimal Roundup usage in the community with proper notification via signage, however additional information was requested prior to a decision being made. 


- ✓ When using the pool furniture at either pool, please be courteous and place it back in its original position when you are done.

 - Pets are not allowed in the pool area, spa area, or clubhouse at any time.




Movie Night In The Park... A Great Adventure For All!

The Board of Directors will consider adoption of a security door installation policy at the July 10th Board of Directors meeting based on the following recommendations from the ARC:



- Security doors must be white, black, or bronze in the noted designs.
- ARC approval forms must be submitted to ensure HOA documents are updated.
- Sample products are available at the clubhouse and on the website at www.parkpaseohoa.com for review.

Security Cameras & Lighting

The Board of Directors will consider adoption of a security camera installation policy at the July 10th Board of Directors meeting based on the following recommendations from the ARC:

- No security cameras are to be installed that compromise the privacy of adjacent neighbors.
- No lights are to be installed which shine into adjacent homes or yards.
- Address lights are to be visible in accordance with City of Irvine regulations.

Monument Sign Project Update

Common Area Use Rule Changes

The Board of Directors has adopted the following rule changes for common area use:

- If more than 12 people will be using the common areas (greenbelts, pool areas, etc.), permission must be obtained from the on-site management office in advance of the event.
- Common areas are to be used for private events only, not business or commercial activity.
- No items may be placed on common areas, including, but not limited to: Bounce houses, Climbing walls and Motorized vehicles

If residents or their guests are discovered to be in violation of the common area rules, the Association reserves the right to contact the Police and/or HOA vendors and/or security to have the items removed immediately.
