February Board Meeting Recap

Monument Signs: Bids were presented at the February 12, 2018 meeting and additional information was needed. Proposals will be reviewed at the March 12, 2018 Board meeting in hopes to select a contractor to start the project. Monument signs will be installed in front of the clubhouse and on the east and west sides of Yale. Stay tuned for future updates.

Annual Election Results

A successful Annual Meeting & Election was held on Monday, December 11, 2017 and Gus Aarnaes, Ric Cox and Kal Patel were re-elected to the Board of Directors, each to serve 2-year terms. Thank you to all owners who sent in their ballots. Your participation is valued and truly appreciated! In addition, the membership voted in favor of the IRS Revenue Ruling 70-604. IRS Revenue Ruling 70-604 allows an Association to make an election that would remove from taxation or defer tax on the Association's excess membership income when filing its taxes as a regular corporation. However, if circumstances dictate that the election would not apply in a given year, it is simply ignored.

Residents renting the clubhouse are required to submit the clubhouse rental application with a room rental fee and security deposit. The room rental fee is due at the time of the reservation. A security deposit in the amount of \$250 is due 30 days prior to the event. The security deposit is refundable if the clubhouse is returned to its original condition, and the keys are returned. Tenants interested in renting the clubhouse must obtain permission from the owner, and the owner is to submit the application. Owners are responsible for their tenants/guests.


