Pool Bee Nets: Please kindly use the bee nets for bee removal only. These nets are hung up in the spa area, main pool area, and Prosa pool. Kindly return the bee nets when not in use and never allow children to play with the nets.

**Don't Forget To Shower:** Please shower before using the pool and spa, and rinse off afterwards to remove any chlorine residue.

#### **Ants & Pest Control**

If you see ants around the clubhouse or patio area, feel free to spray the area, but keep in mind that all spraying must be reported to the onsite office in the event that someone has a reaction to the spraying. Please note that Management cannot spray pesticides due to health regulations and FDA rules.
