Monument Signs

Increased Bees In Our Community

As originally reported in the September 2018 newsletter, bees have been buzzing around throughout the community once again. Due to the high winds, several Eucalyptus trees fell, which had bees inside the trunks. Therefore, the Association has contacted "We Save Bees" to help relocate the bees. Stay clear of any fallen trees or areas where bees are known to swarm. If you see a swarm of bees that has landed in the common area, report it to Lisa Gross at the onsite office.

Budget Season Has Arrived

The Board has been working hard to create the 2019 budget. The approved budget will be mailed to onsite and offsite homeowners by November 30, 2018, and becomes effective January 1, 2019. Don't Forget Your Pool Key


A friendly reminder to all residents to always bring your pool key to gain access to the pool area, spa, wader pool, and tennis courts. No access through the clubhouse is allowed.

Bounce House Reminder

A friendly reminder that bounce houses are not permitted in the in common area unless prior written Board approval is received. If you are planning to host a party with a bounce house in the common area/greenbelt, submit a written request to the Park Paseo Board of Directors **prior** to your event. Remember, written Board approval must be received. Also, additional insurance coverage from your personal insurance company will be requested if approved. Our Community Streets

Our beautiful community streets are not to be used for storage of unused, abandoned, unregistered or collectible cars. These vehicles belong in your garage or in an offsite storage facility. Owners parking unused, abandoned vehicles on our community streets are in violation of our community guidelines as well as city code, which stipulates that vehicles cannot remain parked over 72 hours on city streets. These vehicles must be parked elsewhere. Thank you for doing your part to keep our community streets looking their best.

Lights In Our Community

ADDRESS LIGHT BULBS: Our guidelines and City code stipulate that you must have a visible address number on your house and it must be illuminated at night. This is particularly important for any emergency vehicles to locate an address when needed. The small address light bulbs can be found at The Home Depot if replacement is needed. BURNED-OUT STREET LIGHTS: If you see a that a street light has burned out in our community, please contact Southern California Edison (SCE) directly at 800-611-1911 to report the location and the light pole number. You can also send SCE an electronic service form at www.sce.com/forms/ReportStreetLightOutage.aspx.




