Please bring your box tops stamps to the onsite office and we will donate them to Santiago Hills Elementary School as a gift from the Park Paseo community!




Christmas Tree Pickup



Waste Management will collect and recycle Christmas trees for 2 weeks following Christmas on our regular trash collection day. Trees taller than 6' MUST be cut in half and removed from the stand. ALL decorations including lights, ornaments, and tinsel must also be removed. Place the tree next to your trash. Flocked trees will be collected but not recycled. Please note that Waste Management does not provide large item pick up during this time. All trucks are dedicated to picking up Christmas trees.
