March Board Meeting Highlights

During the March General Session Board Meeting, the Board took the following actions:

- 1. Approved to replace the broken slide at the Prosa playground.
- 2. Discussed a scope of work for the replacement of the sliding glass doors in the clubhouse and to obtain bids.
- 3. Approved the recommendation from the Architectural Committee to add #9 to the non-paint architectural application, which will appear under "Required Plan Details" and will read "Picture of present area being renovated, and a picture of new improvement, whether it be from a brochure, or a drawing from a contractor."
- 4. Approved the replacement of the spa sump pump after the pump stopped working.
- 5. Approved the replacement of the lock at the Prosa main gate, after a piece in the locking mechanism broke.
- 6. Approved a bid to replace the 8 electrical junction boxes at the pool due to safety concerns.
- 7. Approved the placement of a reserve CD at Comerica for 12 months with the highest yielding interest rate.

Monthly Assessment Payments

This just a reminder that the Park Paseo HOA monthly assessment is due by the 1st of each month. If the payment is not received by the 30th, a 10% late fee will be generated, and late interest could be charged. Furthermore, it is very important that payments are received on time because if you carry a balance on your account over 30 days, a \$25 processing fee is charged. This happens because the collections process is initiated, and the account is monitored more closely, and an extra payment reminder letter is sent out. TIME TO SWIM!

With the weather warming up our pool areas will be used more frequently. In an effort to increase safety and reduce vandalism, please be reminded of the following pool rules:

NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY No pets are permitted in the pool/pool area.

Please be sure to lock the pool gates. Do not prop open the gate at any time. Children under 14 years are not permitted in the pool area, unless accompanied by an adult 18 years or older. All guests must be accompanied by a resident. No rough or disorderly conduct, loud music. disruptive behavior, or foul language is permitted. No glass or breakable containers are permitted except for the top deck. If you need a plastic cup, stop by the onsite office 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday. Diving, running, horseplay, roller skating, scooters, skateboarding or bicycles are not permitted. Smoking is prohibited in the pool area. No pool access through clubhouse is allowed. If you forget your pool key, you may not enter the pool area.

Too Many Vehicles Parked On Our Streets

A friendly reminder to all Park Paseo residents that garages and driveways should be used for parking vehicles. Vehicles are being parked on the streets and not all driveways are being used. Please keep in mind that vehicles must move within 72 hours per the Irvine PD or vehicles can be cited and towed. No recreational vehicles are to be parked in the Association except for loading/ unloading. This includes boats, trailers, RVs, dune buggies, off-road vehicles, motor homes, slide-in pickup campers, chassis mounts, 5th-wheel trailers, and converted vans. Please refer to the Association's CC&Rs, Article IX, Section 2 and Article 1, Section 15 of the Irvine PD or Traffic Department. Also, please be aware that vehicles need to be moved on the 2nd and 4th, or the 1st and 3rd Fridays (depending on which side of Yale you reside) for street sweeping.

Satellite Dishes & Cables

To protect and preserve the beauty of our neighborhood, satellite dishes must be installed on the rear half of the house, not on the front where it becomes a visible blight in the neighborhood. Cables must be installed in a manner to minimize visibility (this includes painting cables the same color as the wall to which they are attached). Remember, if you wouldn't like to look at a dish and cables across the street from you, then neither would your neighbors.

Visible Trash Cans

Generally, the Park Paseo community has good compliance with trash cans being stored properly out of sight. If you are storing your trash can where it can be seen from the common area street, it needs to be moved. For those homes with wrought iron fencing and gates, please note that if trash cans are visible from the street, you are subject to letters of violation.
