Arrangements were made to have the newsletter included with the monthly billing from now on, and Associa-PCM approved a refund for the expense the association incurred for the past mailings.

April Board Meeting Highlights

During the April 2019 General Session Board Meeting, the Board took the following actions:

- Approved the draft audit, subject to clarification on a few items.
- Approved Advanced Reserve Solutions to complete the onsite Reserve Study this year.
- Reviewed the playground inspection results and are awaiting quotes for minor repairs.
- Approved Harvest Landscape proposals to fill in bare areas along Prosa, Entrada, Lucero, Alba, and by the Prosa volleyball court. There were 7 trees that were approved to be installed in various locations.
- Approved a proposal from T&S Construction for the replacement of the clubhouse spa pump room doors and the repair of the spa pump room roof.

Children under 14 years are not permitted in the pool area, unless accompanied by an adult. All guests must be accompanied by a resident. No rough or disorderly conduct, disruptive behavior, or foul language is permitted. No loud/amplified music (headphones/earbuds only), No glass or breakable containers except on the top deck. Diving, running, horseplay, roller skating, scooters, skateboarding or bicycles are not permitted. Smoking is prohibited in the pool area. No pool access through clubhouse is allowed. If you forget your pool key, you may not enter the pool area. No boogie boards, surf boards, or large inflatable toys.
