During the January 20, 2020 General Session Board Meeting, the Board of Directors took the following actions:

1. Approved a Harvest Landscape Proposal for new plantings and approved the proposal from We Save Bees Company to remove four hives located high in the trees so that the tree trimming could continue.

Front Yard Maintenance

With Spring on the way, please keep in mind that front yard maintenance needs to be performed regularly. Please take advantage of our lovely Southern California weather to trim bushes and plant material off the sidewalks to avoid a trip hazard. Weeds are troublesome and unappealing when they appear in the cracks of your walkway, sidewalks or driveway. Please take a few minutes to remove the weeds from around your home. This simple process will help to improve the look of your home and our community. Planters should be clean with no weeds, and bare dirt areas should be planted or covered with mulch. Thank you for taking the time to keep your yard looking clean and well maintained.

Exterior Lighting Reminder

Another reminder that your address needs to be clearly seen from the road, and the City of Irvine requires the sign to be illuminated. After a recent inspection, and the newsletter article reminder earlier this year, management has noticed that we still have about half of the address lights out on most streets. Please change your exterior lightbulb immediately if it is burned out. In the event of an emergency at your home, emergency vehicles will have difficulty locating the house. If you have the original light that was installed by the builder, the low-voltage light required is part #6S6-30V-I. Bulbs can be purchased locally at Candela Corporation, Ace Hardware, or at any online bulb distribution store. A follow-up inspection will take place in March, so please be sure to replace your burned-out exterior light right away to avoid receiving a community reminder. Thanks for helping to keep our community safe and well illuminated.



Mailboxes & Post Maintenance

A friendly reminder that the maintenance of mailboxes and posts is the responsibility of each individual homeowner. Please take the time to check to see if your mailbox or post is in need of maintenance or replacement. If your mailbox is rusted or the post is deteriorating, please repair or replace as needed.
