Northstars Update

Welcome to our Association's swim team, the Park Paseo Northstars, where neighbors come together to provide a fun and safe environment for kids to learn and improve their swimming skills. Joining swim team is a great way to make new friends and stay active in the summer. Irvine Swim League (ISL) is closely evaluating guidance from local, state, federal, and global official as we plan for our swim season. Our priority, as always, is safety and well-being of our swimmers, coaches and families. You can get full refund of your team fees until the start of the swim season, which is June 1, 2020. The team practices up to 4 days per week from June 1, 2020 to August 8, 2020 under the supervision of Head Coach Kyle Kim-E. Last year, under Coach Kyle leadership, our team was division IV champion. Coach Kyle won the 2014 ISL Coach of the Year Award and grew up as a star swimmer for the Northstars. He is also the head water polo coach at Northwood High school. Swim practices are flexible to provide reasonable accommodation for families with busy summer plans. You can attend practices and meets as per your schedule. Northstars also offers fun social events throughout the season. Swimmers ages 15-18 can be Volunteer Coaches and we have a new program for 14-year-olds to serve as Team Captains. Both programs provide leadership development, swim coach training experience, and community service hours that can be reported to their high school.

Home Address Light Update

Recently a night inspection was conducted to see how many homes did not have their address number illuminated. Over 300 homes were dark and no addresses could be seen. Your address light needs to be clearly seen from the road, and the City of Irvine requires the number to be illuminated. If you have the original light that was installed by the builder, the low-voltage light required is part #6S6-30V-I and it can be purchased at Crown Ace Hardware on Michelson and Culver in Irvine, or at Candela Corporation in Irvine, 800-922-9226. The Association is not opposed to homeowners installing new address lighting as long as Architectural Standards are followed and an application is submitted for approval prior to installation.
