Please keep in mind that no pole or bracket may be placed in or on the Association's common area property.

American Flag Etiquette



Display the flag only between sunrise and sunset. The flag may be displayed for 24 hours if illuminated in darkness.

Do not display the flag in inclement weather.

Whether displaying the flag vertically or horizontally, make sure the canton of stars is visible on the upper left-hand side.

Do not let the flag touch the ground.

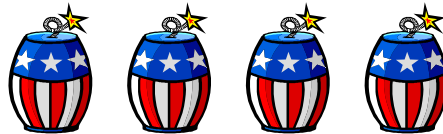
