Ivy & Ficus Vines On Association Walls: Final Reminder!

Another reminder that the PPHOA policy is to trim the wall ivy and Ficus vines on all Association walls two bricks down. Additionally, the City of Irvine maintains the perimeter walls from Christamon to Glorieta and has advised the Board they will be consistent with the two brick down trimming to provide a cohesive, well maintained look with the surrounding areas. Please be advised it is the homeowners' responsibility to secure their own landscape or wall coverings on their side of the walls. The Ficus vines are particularly invasive and destructive to the walls if not maintained properly. Additionally, when the wall covering is left un-maintained, it makes it very difficult to see if there is any damage to the walls. Beginning in November, when the vines begin to go dormant, the City of Irvine and the PPHOA landscapers will be trimming all vines on the walls two bricks down and shearing the vines close to the walls to promote better more uniform growth in the spring, and keep the weight of the vines from pulling away and falling off the walls.
