Help Us Stop Scavengers!

A Message From The City of Irvine

Call it a sign of the times, but as the economy has weakened, scavenging of recyclables has been on the rise. In Irvine, scavengers have been going through neighborhoods and parks before the recycling trucks get there to remove recyclables from carts and bins. The City ordinance prohibits any person other than the City's waste hauler from removing recyclable items from the carts and bins. Scavenging from these carts or bins is a crime, and the City of Irvine does enforce this law and investigates the cases that are reported.

Theft of recyclable items can have an adverse impact on the City's financial resources. Scavenging results in lost revenue from the sale of these materials, revenue that helps pay for collection costs and funds other programs and services. Theft of recyclables has also led to vandalism of City equipment, such as recycling containers in City parks. Scavenging is called a "gateway crime" because people who steal recyclables begin to believe that it is okay to take something else. Scavenging encourages unknown people, some of whom are highly organized, to come into our neighborhoods with the intent of taking recyclables. This can also lead to other types of crime, such as trespassing or theft of larger or more valuable items, as well as breaking and entering.

If you see any scavenging, <u>do not</u> confront the scavenger. Instead, jot down a description of the person and vehicle, including a license plate number, if possible and contact the following:

To report scavenging during regular business hours, call the Irvine Recycling Hotline at 949-724-7669. At all other times, contact the Irvine PD directly at 949-724-7000.

Thieves posing as magazine subscription solicitors are knocking on doors, and if no answer is received, going to the back of the home and breaking in, sometimes violently. If an unknown person comes to your door, do not ignore the knock or doorbell ring. Talk to the person through the closed/locked door and ask what they want. If they are persistent about you opening the door or refuse to leave, call the Irvine Police Department immediately at 949-724-7200 or 911.

See A Violation? Put It In Writing...

If you see a violation in our community, please take the time to put it in writing. Be sure to include the offending homeowner's address. And send the information regarding the alleged violation to Trevor Fenwick at PCM. The issue will be verified on the next scheduled walk-though of the community and the appropriate letter will be sent as necessary. In fairness to all residents, the complaint must be received in writing. Anonymous complaints will not be addressed.

Reporting Maintenance Items

If you notice an item in need of maintenance within our community including lighting, landscape concerns, irrigation leaks, etc., please report it to PCM in a timely manner. Please don't wait until the Board Meeting to report a maintenance item. It is more efficient to contact PCM as a work order can be issued immediately to the appropriate vendor. Thanks!

Commercial vehicles are classified as recreational vehicles (motor homes, trailers, camper vans, boats, etc), commercial-type vehicles, (stake bed trucks, tank trucks, dump trucks, step vans concrete trucks, limousines, any vehicle distributing or advertising a company name, etc.) buses or vans designed to accommodate more than 10 people, vehicles having more than two axles, trailers inoperable vehicles, etc.
