The roles of the landscaping committee at the Park Paseo HOA include the following:

1. Help the HOA manager to oversee the maintenance and upkeep of common areas and landscaped areas, including lawns, gardens, trees, and shrubs.
2. Assist the HOA manager to work with landscape contractors and other service providers to ensure the quality of landscaping services and maintenance.
3. Helping the board to monitor and address homeowner concerns and complaints related to landscaping and common areas.
4. Organizing activities for improving community awareness and engagement to appreciate and enhance the importance of green landscape in the Park Paseo neighborhood.
5. Making recommendations for landscape maintenance and improvement, including planting and removal of trees, plants, grass, etc. Helping the board select contractors, suppliers, products, and materials. Make suggestions.

The committee will meet at least once a month with the representative of the landscape contractor and property management company for a walk-through of the community to assess the condition and maintenance of the community's landscaping.



GOOGLE FIBER INTERNET AT PARK PASEO

NEW ELECTRONIC KEY FOBs



New electronic fobs are now used to access all Park Paseo HOA facilities (including Clubhouse Pool, Prosa Pool, Tennis Courts, and Hot Tub). The old mechanical (Medeco) keys have been disabled. Every Park Paseo resident (homeowner or tenant) must pick up the new key fobs in person at the HOA office at the clubhouse on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday between 9am - 5pm. Please bring a valid photo ID and your current metal (Medeco) keys to collect new key fobs.

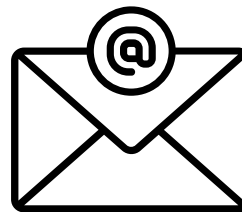

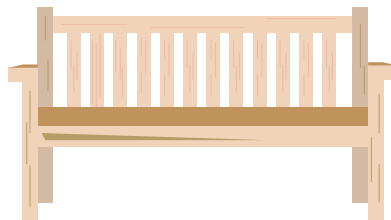


PICKING UP AFTER YOUR DOG

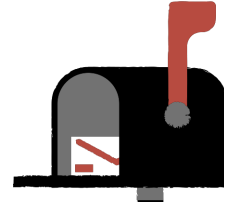
HOLIDAY LIGHTS & DECORATIONS

NO SCHOOL DROP-OFF AT CLUBHOUSE PARKING LOT

The HOA Clubhouse parking lot must NOT be used as a location to pick up or drop off students attending Santiago Hills Elementary School.



MAILBOX & POST MAINTENANCE

The maintenance of mailboxes and their posts is the responsibility of each individual homeowner. The mailboxes are a rural style in black color on posts that are 42 inches in height. Thanks for helping to make our community look great!

2023 HOA MONTHLY ASSESSMENTS

Since January 1, 2023, the monthly assessment has been increased by 7% to \$138.00 per month. This increase is due to the increasing costs of labor and materials and inflation in general. In an attempt to curb increasing costs, the association has bid out services to try and get competitive prices. The upward price pressure on tree trimming, landscaping services, and patrol services are some of the areas of increasing costs.
