FLAG ETIQUETTE

HOW TO FOLD THE FLAG



Bring corners together lengthwise.



Fold again lengthwise



From stripe end, bring corner to flat edge



Fold in triangle pattern up to stars end



Folded flag will be triangular.



FLYING THE FLAG AT HALF-MAST

Hoist flag to top of staff before lowering to half mast; raise to top again before lowering at sunset.

How long flag flies at half-mast



30 DAYS
 Death of a president or former president

10 DAYS
 Death of current or former vice president, chief justice or speaker of the house.

1 DAY
 Death of a governor, U.S. senator or representative.

MEMORIAL DAY
 Fly the flag at half-mast until noon, then raise to top of flagpole.



Fireworks Safety Tips

- ★ Never allow **children** to play with or ignite fireworks.
- ★ **Never** try to **re-light** or **pick up** fireworks that have not ignited fully.
- ★ Keep a **bucket of water** or a **garden hose** handy in case of fire or other mishap.
- ★ Make sure fireworks are **legal** in your area before buying or using them.
- ★ Light fireworks **one at a time**, then **move back** quickly.
